#### Special Ordinance No. 33, 2023

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC ALLEY LOCATED IN THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, VIGO COUNTY, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDERED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana.

SECTION 1. Pursuant of the provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12, it is desired and deemed necessary to vacate a portion of a public alley located in the City of Terre Haute, Vigo County, Indiana, which is now laid out and existing in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, and described as follows:

> Beginning at the northeast corner of Lot 174 in Highland Place (commonly known as 1601 Lafayette Avenue), thence east approximately sixteen (16) feet to the northwest corner of Lot 118 in Highland Place (Commonly known as 1630 Elizabeth Avenue) thence south approximately four hundred (400) feet to the southwest corner of Lot 127 in Highland Place (Commonly known as 2900 North 17th Street) thence west approximately sixteen (16) feet to the southeast corner of Lot 181 in Highland Place (Commonly known as 2901 North 16th Street) thence north approximately four hundred (400) feet to the point of beginning.

Commonly bound by Elizabeth Street to the north, 17th Street to the east, Carl Avenue to the south, and 16th Street and Lafayette Avenue to the west

SECTION 2. Be it further ordained that said portion of said alley in the City of Terre Haute. Indiana, above described, be and the same is vacated and will revert to the abutting properties, subject to the continuation of any and all existing easement rights for public utilities.

**SECTION 3.** Be it further ordained that the City Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to furnish a copy of this Ordinance to the Recorder of Vigo County, Indiana, for recording, and to the Auditor of Vigo County, Indiana.

WHEREAS, an emergency exits for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance, the same shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Common Council of Terre Haute, and its approval by the Mayor and publications as by law provided.
