#### SPECIAL ORDINANCE NO. 8, 2017

AN ORDINANCE VACATING A PORTION OF A PUBLIC STREET LOCATED IN THE CITY OF TERRE HAUTE, VIGO COUNTY, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDERED by the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana.

SECTION 1. Pursuant to the provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12, It is desired and deemed necessary to vacate a portion of a public street located in the City of Terre Haute, Vigo County, Indiana, which is now laid out and existing in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, and described as follows:

Part of section 9, Township 12 North 9 West, Harrison Township, Vigo County, Indiana, described as follows:

Part of Carl Avenue (also referred to as an alley) as shown on the plat of Ouabasche Acres First Addition, as found in Plat Book 17, Page 47, and Ratteree's Collett Park Addition as found in Plat Book 11, Page 52 all records of the Vigo County Recorder's Office, described as follows:

Beginning at the Southeast corner of Lot 1, Block 2 in said Ouabasche Acres First Addition; thence South 16 feet more or less to the Northeast corner of Lot 23 in said Ratteree's Collett Park Addition; thence West 142 feet along the North line of said Lot 23, to the Northwest corner thereof; thence North 16 feet more or less to the South line of the aforesaid Lot 1; thence East 142 feet along the South line of said Lot 1 to the place of beginning, containing 2556 square feet, more or less.

Commonly located near 2800 North 6 1/2 Street, Terre Haute, Indiana 47804.

SECTION 2. Be It further ordained that said portion of said street in the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, above described, be and the same is vacated and will revert to the abutting properties, subject to the continuation of any and all existing easement rights for public utilities.

SECTION 3. Be it further ordained that the City Clerk be, and he is hereby directed to furnish a copy of this Ordinance to the Recorder of Vigo County, Indiana, for recording, and to the Auditor of Vigo County, Indiana.

WHEREAS, an emergency exists for the immediate taking effect of this Ordinance, the same shall be In full force and effect from and after Its passage by the Common Council of Terre Haute, and Its approval by the Mayor and publication as by law provided.

Nancy Jo Haddix, petitioner, and Kathy L Flowers, petitioners, and respectfully petitions and requests the legislative body of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana to vacate that portion of a Public Street described below pursuant to the various provisions of I.C. 36-7-3-12, and In support of this Petition would show to the Common Council of said City as follows;

1. Nancy Jo Haddix, petitioner, is the owner of the following described real estate located in Vigo County, State of Indiana;

Lot Number one (1) in Block Number Two (2) in Ouabasche Acres First Addition, Being a Subdivision of the following described real estate in Vigo County, Indiana To-wit:

Commencing 442 feet North of the Southeast Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Of Section 9, Township 12 North Range 9 West; thence West 762.5 feet North 441.44 feet; thence East 762.5 feet to the East line of Section 9; thence South 441 Feet to the place of beginning.

- 4. That the portion of the Public Street to be vacated as set forth above may be more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

- 7. The proposed vacation would not hinder the use of a public way by the neighborhood In which said portion of the Public Street Is located or to which they are contiguous since the Petitioners are the owners of all lands abutting said portion of said Public Street, and all other landowners in the area have and will continue to have direct access to public ways; as set forth above, the proposed vacation of said portion of said Public Street would not make access to any land by any person by means of a public way difficult or inconvenient; nor would said vacation hinder any member of the public's access to a church, school or other public building or place, nor will it interfere in any way with fire protection or police protection for property located within the City of Terre Haute, Indiana.
- 8. The name and address of the owners of land that abut that portion of the Public Street above proposed to be vacated are the Petitioners herein.

WHEREAS, Petitioners respectfully request and petition the Common Council of the City of Terre Haute, Indiana, after hearing on this Petition In accordance with law, to:

- Adopt an Ordinance vacating that portion of the Public Street referred to and described above, subject to existing easement rights for public utilities;
- Cause the Clerk of the City of Terre Haute to furnish copies of said Vacation Ordinance to the County Recorder of Vigo County for recording and to the county Auditor, and to thereupon cause the Recorder to release said Ordinance to the Vigo County Area Planning Department for distribution In accordance with the City's Zoning Ordinance and Subdivision Code.
